Villa Kulak stands as a contemporary haven, spanning three inviting floors, ensuring a comfortable and modern retreat for your stay. This spacious residence is equipped with all the conveniences of modern living, including WI-FI, air conditioning, and Smart TVs, enhancing the overall experience of your stay.

The ground floor introduces you to an expansive living room, recently redecorated to exude a sense of openness and tranquillity. 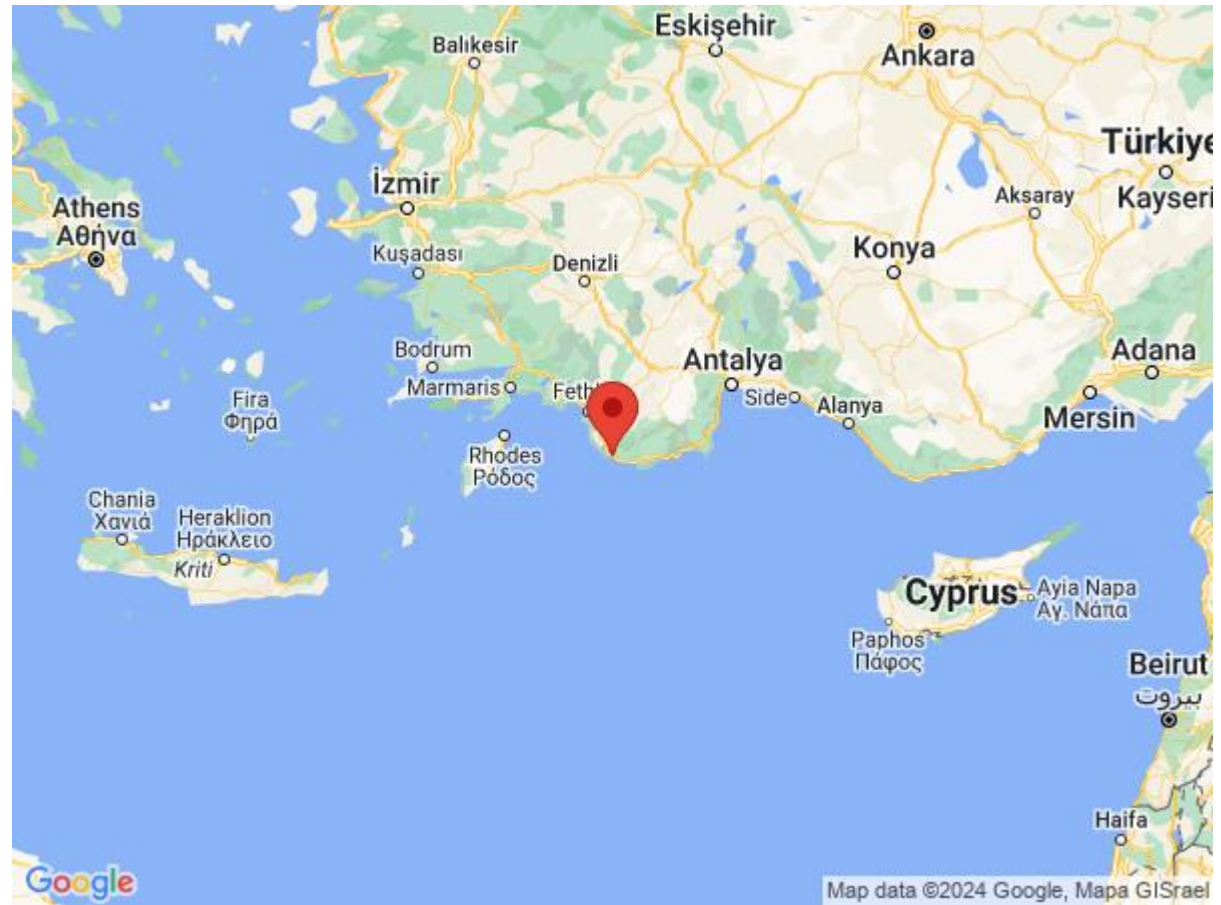
Kalkan's charming Old Town boasts narrow streets adorned with traditional Ottoman architecture, providing a picturesque backdrop for leisurely strolls. For history enthusiasts, there is an array of museums in town, ranging from a toy museum to a museum of local history, meaning there is something for everyone. The coastal town of Kalkan started as a humble fishing village and has since evolved into a vibrant destination, blending its historical roots with contemporary sophistication. Visitors can meander through the labyrinthine streets, discovering boutique shops, charming cafes, and waterfront bars that come alive at night. The town's lively nightlife complements its relaxed daytime ambience.

Kalkan's beaches add another layer to its allure. Kaputas Beach, with its striking turquoise waters and golden sands, invites sun-seekers to unwind and indulge in water sports. Meanwhile, the renowned Patara Beach, part of a protected area, spans an impressive 12km and offers a serene escape surrounded by natural beauty.

A short drive from Kalkan, approximately 30km away, Kaçanik enchants with its picturesque harbour and vibrant atmosphere. Diving and fishing enthusiasts can explore the clear Mediterranean waters surrounding Kaçanik, teeming with underwater caves, colourful coral reefs, and diverse marine life. Kaçanik also boasts well-preserved ancient ruins and some of Turkey's finest shopping streets, making it a town that seamlessly merges history with modernity.

A visit to Patara is a must for a day filled with sun and sand. Just 16km away from Kalkan, Patara offers a 12 km-long beach, providing a tranquil escape surrounded by natural splendour. The beach also serves as the backdrop to the ancient city of Patara, offering a unique blend of historical exploration and beach relaxation.

To enhance your coastal experience, consider a boat trip from Kalkan, exploring the nearby bays and islands. These excursions offer opportunities for swimming, snorkelling, and basking in the Mediterranean sun, providing a memorable addition to your South Turkey holiday.

What you should know...

- Guests should be aware that three new villas are under construction nearby, though construction work is not permitted after mid-May to respect the tourist season.
- There are a great range of amenities and beaches within walking distance, but if you wish to bring a car, there is on-street parking available.
- If you wish to book extras and services such as boat trips, grocery shopping, event planning and airport transfers, this can be arranged for you.

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: £200 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- Arrival time: 4.00 p.m.
- Departure time: 10.00 a.m.
- Energy costs included?: Yes, included in the rental price.
- Heating costs included?: Yes, included in the rental price.
- Linen & towels included?: Yes, included in the rental price. If there is cleaning scheduled, there will be a new set provided.
- Pool towels included?: Yes.
- End of stay cleaning included?: If stay is less than a week a £70 cleaning fee will be payable locally. If stay is 7 days or more cleaning will be included. For stays over two weeks, mid-stay clean will be provided. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- Internet access?: Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on the local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- Minimum stay: 7 nights from June to end of August.
5 nights all other dates.
- Changeover day: Saturday from June to end of August.

- Pets welcome?: Not allowed.
- Smoking Allowed?: Smoking & Vaping are not permitted.
- Tax: Included in the rental price.
- Insurance: Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, loss of personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- Other Ts and Cs: Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- Other 2: In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- Other 3: Please note, at the time of writing (December 2023), 3 new villas are in the process of being completed in close proximity to Villa Kulak - they are not visible in the image gallery shown on our webpage. We anticipate that the villas will be completed over the winter 2023/2024 period and new images to show the new-builds will be published on this website in the spring of 2024 (construction work will not continue beyond the middle of May in line with local authority rules, therefore, occupants of Villa Kulak will not be disturbed by construction noise during the normal tourist season)

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
