Location & Local Information

Located between the majestic Aiguilles Rouges nature reserve and the iconic Mont-Blanc, the Chamonix valley stands at the crossroads of Switzerland and Italy, a captivating destination that transcends borders. Home to 14,000 residents off-season and a staggering 80,000 tourist beds, the valley is a testament to the allure of its breathtaking surroundings. In 1921, the town of Chamonix earned the prestigious right to bear the name Chamonix-Mont-Blanc, a title befitting its panoramic backdrop dominated by the towering Mont-Blanc, the highest peak in Western Europe, rightfully earning its moniker as the "roof of Europe."

Encompassing 16 villages, including Servoz, Les Houches, Chamonix, and Vallorcine, the Chamonix-Mont-Blanc Valley is a community of communes that has evolved into the global capital of mountaineering and skiing since the historic ascent of Mont Blanc in 1786. With 6,000 primary residences and twice as many secondary residences, Chamonix-Mont-Blanc has transformed into a year-round haven. In winter, novices find solace on dedicated slopes like Les Planards and Le Savoy in Chamonix, while the adventurous explore the Aiguille du Midi cable car, ascending to 3,842 metres for the renowned offpiste descent of the Vallée Blanche.

Chamonix-Mont-Blanc's historical roots as a summer vacation spot persist, offering an array of activities such as hiking, mountain biking, mountaineering, paragliding, canyoning, rafting, golf, horse riding, paintball, and refreshing swims in pools or lakes. Guided tours unveil the wonders of the Aiguilles Rouges reserve, and the Itinerio application, available for rent, guides visitors through seven geo-guided routes and 110 points of interest. The Montenvers cogwheel train reveals the breathtaking panorama of the Mer de Glace.

In winter, the valley transforms into a skier's paradise, offering alpine skiing, ski touring, cross-country skiing, dog sledging, snowshoeing, speed riding, skating, and sledging. Regardless of the season, Chamonix-Mont-Blanc caters to visitors' well-being with spas, shops, bars, restaurants, and nightclubs, ensuring an all-encompassing and unforgettable experience in this alpine gem.
