Perched high on a hill above the enchanting harbour of Bodrum, Turkey, Villa Koton is a splendid 5-bedroom villa accommodating up to 16 guests in a harmonious blend of comfort and style.

Stepping into Villa Koton, guests are greeted by a sense of tranquillity and the warmth of Turkish hospitality. The heart of the villa is undoubtedly the spacious living and dining area, adorned with an array of plush furnishings that invite you to unwind. Large floor-to-ceiling windows frame breathtaking views of the azure Aegean Sea, creating a seamless connection between the comfy indoors and the scenic outdoors.

The living room seamlessly transitions into a well-appointed dining area, where moments of conviviality unfold over sumptuous meals prepared in the fully equipped, modern kitchen. Ascending the stairs, or better yet, ascending in the private elevator, reveals two further floors and five well-appointed bedrooms, each an oasis of comfort and privacy. Floor-to-ceiling windows opening out onto private balconies with sea views bathe each room in floods of natural light. The bedrooms cater to various preferences, featuring a mix of sleeping arrangements to ensure absolute comfort for a diversity of needs.

The first floor features two bedrooms, the first contains a queen-sized bed and a toddler bed, ideal for families. Throw in a lounge space with a TV, dedicated workspace, and balcony with furniture and sea views. The second bedroom has two single beds, a lounge area with a TV, a balcony with furniture, and an ensuite bathroom with a walk-in shower.

The upper floor contains three bedrooms, two of which contain queen-sized beds, lounge areas with TV, balconies with furniture, and ensuite bathrooms with walk-in showers. Lastly, the fifth bedroom consists of two double beds, one single bed, TV and lounge area, balcony with furniture, and ensuite bathroom with walk-in shower.

Beyond the sliding doors of the spacious living area reveals an expansive



terrace and a stunning turquoise swimming pool. Surrounded by sun loungers, cushioned lounge areas, and the lush greenery of a garden and privacy hedge, the swimming pool is the focal point of the patio.

The outdoor spaces offer a bevy of al fresco dining settings and comfy nooks. As day turns to night, the villa comes alive with the gentle glow of strategically placed outdoor lighting, enhancing the enchanting ambience.

With its harmonious blend of modern comfort and Mediterranean allure, this 5-bedroom villa overlooking Bodrum stands as an unparalleled retreat, promising an unforgettable escape for you and your loved ones.

Location & Local Information

Strategically located near glamorous Bodrum's attractions, the villa provides a gateway to explore the region's rich history and vibrant culture. The peninsula of Bodrum itself is relatively small but densely packed with fine dining and low-key restaurants, high-end shopping, a blossoming wine industry and all the marvels of the Turkish Riviera.

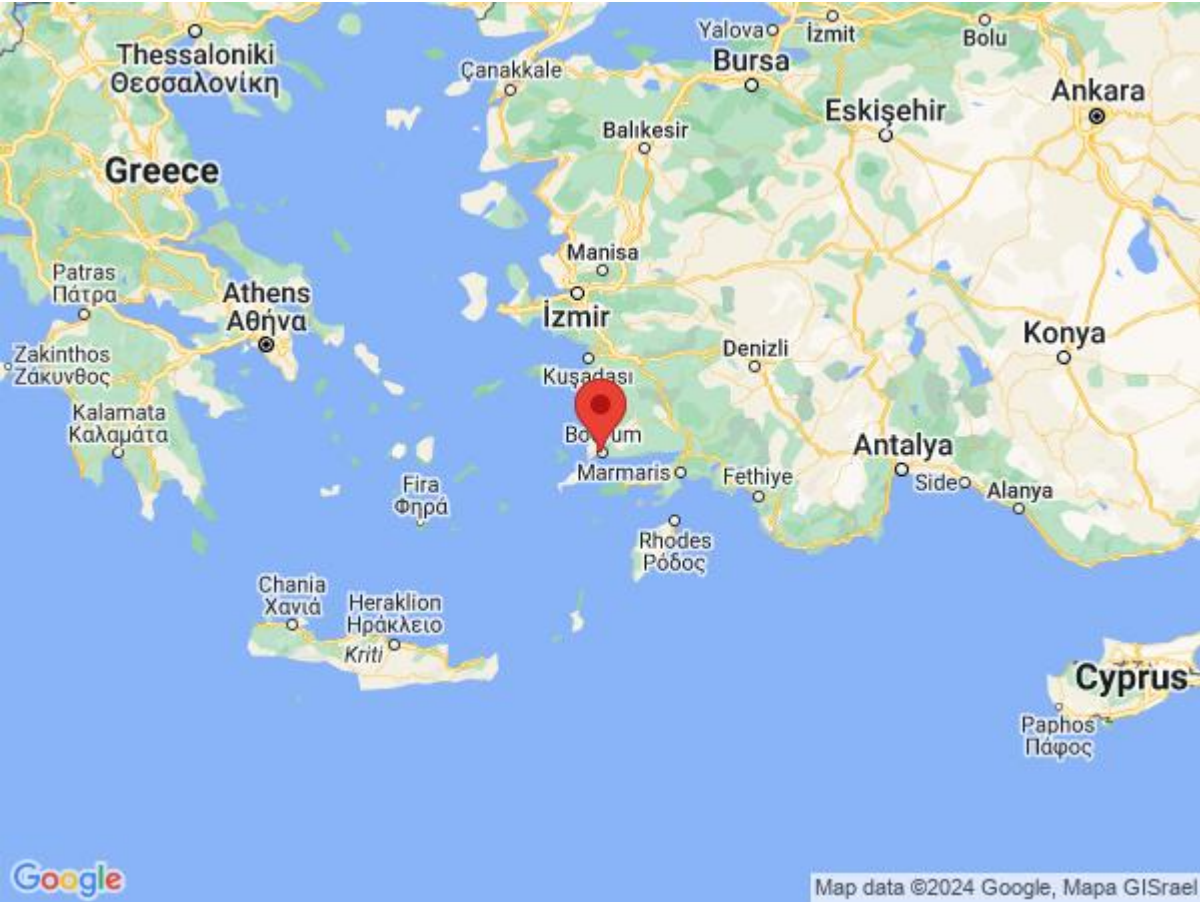
Bodrum attracts Turkey's rich and famous every summer; their destination? Bodrum Peninsula's public beaches. Yahsi Beach (20-minute drive) has some of the most pristine waters, Torba Beach (15-minute drive) is found in a protected cove and fringed by pine forests.

For those with a taste for history, the Castle of St Peter (9-minute drive) – perched on a natural peninsula in Bodrum Bay, was built in the 15th century by crusader knights from England, France, Italy and Germany, who each constructed one of the castle's four towers. But that's just the beginning. Bodrum is also home to the famed ruins of Halicarnassus (9-minute drive). Built in the 4th century BC and considered one of the seven wonders of the ancient world, its renowned mausoleum was destroyed by an earthquake in the 11th century (though some of its stones were used in constructing the Castle of St Peter).

Villa Koton's breathtaking views over Bodrum as it rolls its way down to the sea reveals the town's charming geography and architecture – white houses ranging over the hills under a bright stripe of blue sea. But perhaps you're not keen to climb up and down hills on a hot day. That's understandable. Thankfully, there are alternatives, including a Segway tour that explores the town's beauty from all angles without breaking a sweat.

Feeling international? No worries, the Greek island of Kos is only a mile away, and the island of Rhodes is only a little farther. Indeed, these Greek islands are so close that Bodrum locals regularly take ferries for day trips and shopping. You'll need your passport, but otherwise, Greece promises to be a great adventure.

Wine lovers will be happy to hear that Turkish viticulture is having a renaissance. The vineyards of Karnas (37-minute drive) offer a complete wine-tasting and dining experience. Make sure to try their Zinfandel and award-winning Syrah.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government [Website](#) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
