As part of the world's largest ski area, the Three Valleys, Saint Martin de Belleville enjoys impeccable maintenance and grooming, a standard befitting the renowned Courchevel.

Embark on a skiing odyssey across the vast expanse of Les 3 Vallées, boasting an impressive 600 km of slopes served by over 160 ski lifts. Most of these slopes sit above 1800m altitude, catering to all skill levels. Saint-Martin de Belleville seamlessly connects to the Ménuires area and offers swift access to Val Thorens, where Savoyard authenticity mingles effortlessly with modern comfort and charm.

From historical monuments to narrow streets and local secrets, the village presents an immersive experience where eras, styles, and genres intertwine discreetly, offering a unique kind of luxury.

The 22 hamlets comprising Saint-Martin de Belleville, divided into five districts including Le Centre, Les Grangeraias, Les Places, Villarencel, and La Villette, provide a picturesque backdrop for your alpine retreat. Ski enthusiasts can easily commence their adventure from the village centre via the ski lift or the Saint-Martin gondola from Les Grangeraias. Luxurious and authentic chalets, such as Pure White Cristal and Pure Black Cristal, grace the town centre, exemplifying the high-end services and accommodations available.

Beyond the slopes, free shuttles weave through the hamlets, offering seamless connectivity. The village thrives with activities for families or friends, from dog sledging and snowshoeing to ski touring and cross-country skiing.
