Location & Local Information

Embarking on the scenic drive up the West Coast of Barbados, just before reaching the island's northern tip, you'll encounter the charming town of Speightstown in the parish of St Peter. Steeped in history, this town, over 350 years old, wears its colonial past proudly. Once a bustling port facilitating trade with Bristol in the United Kingdom, Speightstown earned the moniker "Little Bristol." Its significance as a fortified port during the 1650s, repelling the attempted invasion by Admiral Sir George Ayscue, is evident in the remnants of ancient cannons that still dot the coastline.

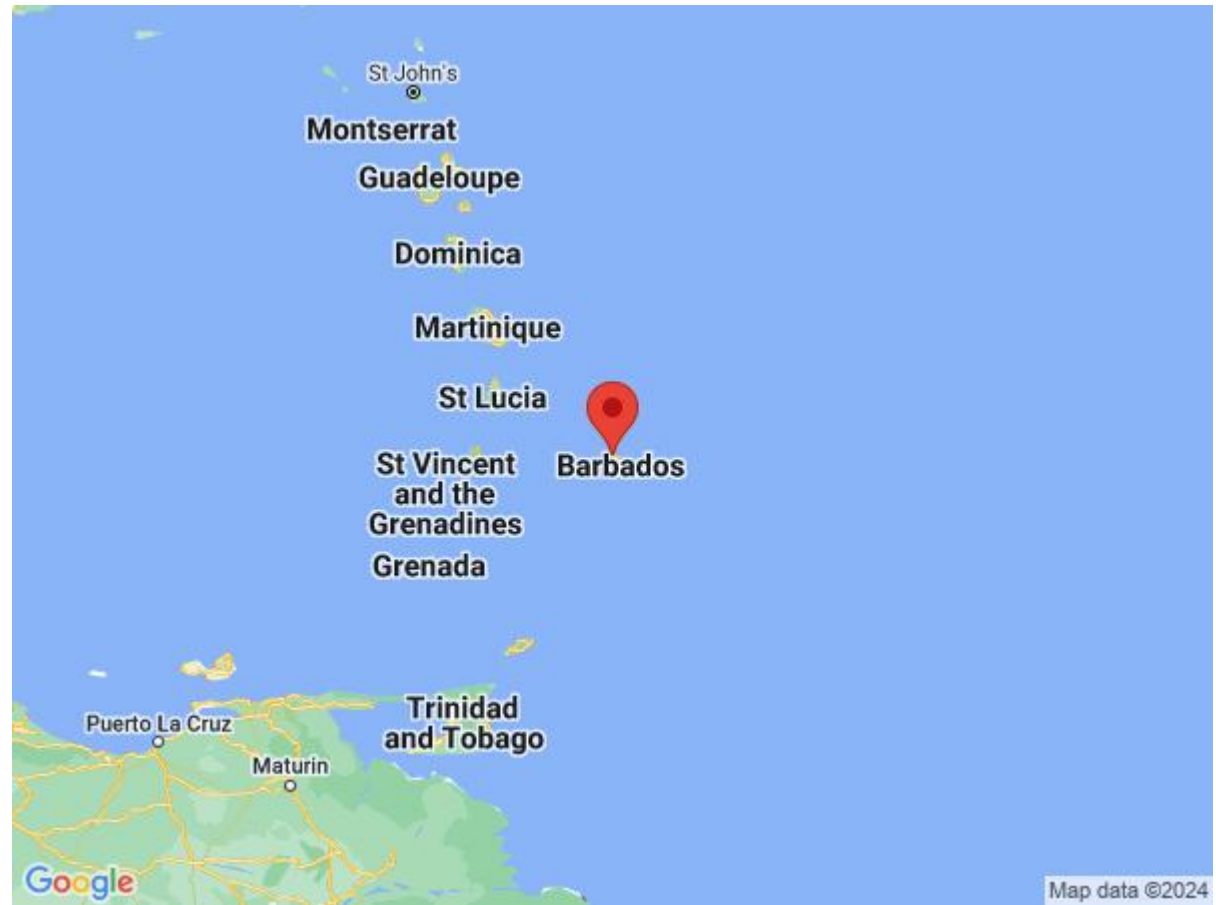
Speightstown's coastal allure offers enchanting spaces like the Speightstown Esplanade, a favourite among locals and visitors. With its stunning ocean views and shaded areas, it's the perfect spot for a leisurely stroll along the boardwalk or a tranquil evening basking in the cooling Caribbean breeze, accompanied by a breathtaking sunset.

Delving deeper into Speightstown's colonial roots, architectural gems like Arlington House, constructed around 1750, stand as living landmarks. Transformed into a modern, interactive museum, the three floors narrate Speightstown's memories, plantation histories, and wharf tales. A testament to the town's resilience and evolution through time. Not to be missed is St Peter's Parish Church, an architectural marvel rooted in Barbadian history. Built in 1837, its Gothic-influenced Georgian style, fortified mediaeval tower, and incorporation of the number 7 in design make it a unique spiritual haven.

Exploring Speightstown extends beyond history and architecture. Local markets beckon with fresh fish, fruits, and vegetables, inviting conversations with friendly vendors. Nearby shopping centres offer a taste of village life, and dining options, like the renowned Fisherman's Pub, immerse you in authentic Bajan flavours.

Art enthusiasts will be captivated by the 'trompe l'oeil' mural adorning Jordan's Supermarket. Spanning 80 feet by 20 feet, the mural, a collaborative masterpiece by local artist Don Small and renowned muralist John Pugh, intricately weaves together symbols of Barbadian culture in a mesmerising visual spectacle.

Speightstown, the most northern Barbadian town, seamlessly blends its colonial heritage with modern vibrancy. While it may be a tranquil escape from the hustle of other areas on the island, the rich experiences it offers make the journey well worth it. In Speightstown, history, culture, and everyday life converge to create an authentic and unforgettable Barbadian experience.
